<b>palmatum</b> (Japanese Maple)	Large shrub with a low rounded head. Bright green lobed leaves and fantastic autumn colour. Like sheltered moist soils, not chalk.	70-100	60.00

<b>grandiflora Goliath</b> (Evergreen Magnolia)	Large pyramidal evergreen shrub. Rounded glossy green leaves with felt-like rust-brown undersides. Fragrant cup-shaped, creamy-white flowers produced in the summer. Moist soils and tolerant of heavy clay. Flowers produced on young plants.	150-175	175.00
<b>soulangiana</b>	Deciduous large shrub. Flowers appearing before the leaves in spring are tulip-shaped, white flushed purple. Not good for shallow chalk soils.	150-175	60.00

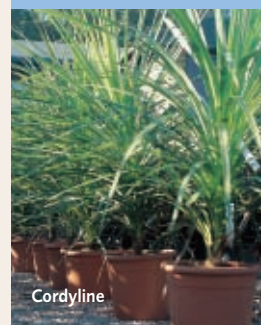

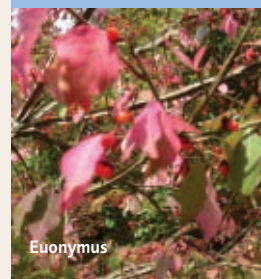

<b>domestica</b> (Sacred Bamboo)	Decorative evergreen upright shrub of medium size. The large compound green leaves are tinged pinkish-red in spring & autumn. Fruits are red. Should be given a sheltered position in full sun in any well-drained soil.	50-60 125-150	20.00 85.00

<b>Pyracantha</b> ★ 🌿 🌿

<b>ilex</b>	Large shrub or tree. Leaves can look similar to holly. Tolerant of coastal exposure.	See tree section

<b>carlcephalum</b>	A compact shrub producing large very fragrant pink-budded white flowers in May. Rich autumn colour.	125-150	45.00
