

## GROWTH PROMOTING MYCORRHIZAE PRODUCTS

It is now widely recognised that 90% of plants have an association with mycorrhizal fungi. Plants treated with Rootgrow show superior establishment and better natural vigour. Transplanting success rates increase, plants will develop better root systems and are better able to cope with drought.

Rootgrow Professional is a blend of UK origin mycorrhizal fungi and the first product of its kind to gain full RHS endorsement.

Plants that will benefit from Rootgrow include:-

- Bareroot transplants and whips
- Bareroot trees
- Specimen Trees & Shrubs in containers
- Roses
- Evergreen Hedges (e.g. yew, box, holly and conifers)

For container grown and rootballed stock, Rootgrow is applied as a powder into the base of the plant hole in DIRECT CONTACT with the roots.

With bareroot plants, the powder is mixed up with water to form a paste and the roots are dipped prior to planting.

As a general rule, allow 2g Rootgrow per litre of rootball/pot on 10L pots and above.

N.B Rootgrow does not work on Brassicas, Rhododendrons, Azaleas, Heathers, Cranberries or Blueberries.
